2023 FEMS European Materials Gold Medal

The FEMS Board is currently seeking nominees from the Member Societies for its most prestigious award, the FEMS European Materials Gold Medal. The award is presented to active materials scientists or engineers for exceptional contributions to Materials Science and Engineering.

The FEMS European Materials Gold Medal is awarded biennially and will be presented at the 2023 FEMS EUROMAT Conference (3-7 September in Frankfurt, Germany) where the winner of the award is expected to give a plenary lecture.

The winner's name and that of their Member Society will also be featured in an interview on the FEMS website.

Nominations

The nomination should include a CV and a list of publications (with a list of independent citations) and invited lectures. Also, a list of former PhD students and post-docs trained by the nominee should be included, indicating the positions presently held by these younger colleagues. Three letters of support from individuals from the Materials Science and Engineering field, familiar with the nominee's achievements, should be included with the nomination. A citation of no more than 100 words should be submitted. Nominees should preferably (but not exclusively) have European nationality or have conducted much of their research work at a European University or Institute. The nomination should be submitted to the FEMS Secretary, Ms Efi Fragkou, at secretary@fems.org by 31 January 2023. More information can be found on the FEMS website.

Responsibility for the selection of the winner rests with the FEMS Award Selection Committee. The ASC will review nominations and recommend one candidate to the FEMS Board no later than six months prior to the presentation of the award.

We look forward to receiving your nominations.
